Exhaustion of Domestic Remedies

By the order of this court dated 2 October 2019 the Applicant was refused permission to appeal to the Court of Appeal in respect of the order of Recorder Bond dated 6 September 2019. Pursuant to CPR 52.5(1) the Applicant has no right to request a reconsideration of the refusal of permission to appeal at an oral hearing.

Where permission to appeal to this Court has been refused no appeal may be made against this decision to the Supreme Court of the United Kingdom: see section 54(4) of the Access to Justice Act 1999.

Accordingly, there is no further right of appeal in English domestic law and I confirm that the parties have exhausted the domestic appellate process.
